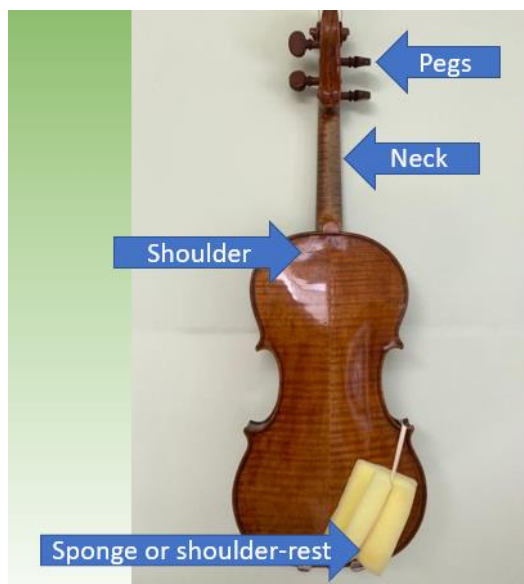


String Instruments - COVID-19 Cleaning (taken from Music Mark)

COVID-19 virus particles are believed to survive for two to five days on hard surfaces³. After five days of not being played, normal cleaning of any equipment will suffice.

Disinfectant wipes and/or sprays are effective but bear in mind that ***some disinfectant products will damage varnished or polished finishes***. Hot, soapy water is just as effective as disinfectant wipes



- Spray some cleaning product on a cloth
- Wipe the chinrests of violins or violas and dry with a cloth



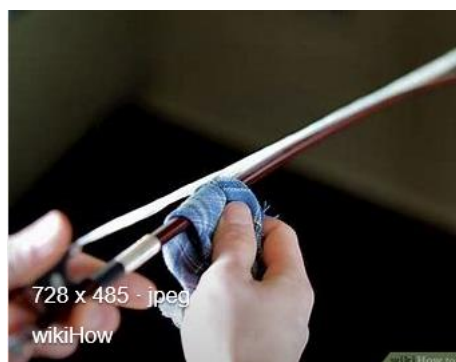
- Wipe the neck and dry with a cloth



- Wipe the fingerboard (feed the flat cloth CAREFULLY underneath the strings) and dry with a cloth



- Wipe the lower end of the bow and dry with a cloth



DO NOT GET CLEANING PRODUCT ON THE BOW HAIR!!!
