

## **WOODWIND CLEANING: - CLARINET**

- 1. Remove the reed and throw away.**
2. Using an anti-bac cloth, wipe over the clarinet externally and dry with a paper towel.
3. Using the cleaning pull-through, spray with anti-bac solution and pull through each section of the clarinet pay particular attention to the mouthpiece. Depending on the state of the mouthpiece, it may require brushing out too! Use the small wire brush also sprayed with anti-bac solution or in hot soapy water to clean any residue on the mouthpiece and then dry with a paper towel. (Alternatively, if there is no cleaning pull-through you can use a flute stick and an anti-bac wipe to clean inside the clarinet)
4. Place the pull-through in plastic bag, to be taken away for washing.

**5. Please make a note if there is no cleaning pull-through present in the case!**
